

Exam 1: Oral exam

- This exam will be based on topics we have covered in class.
- The exam will last 5 minutes and is worth 50% of your final grade.
- I will ask you two questions from the following list. You must speak for a minimum of 2 minutes per question.
- I may also ask follow up questions that are not on the list to keep the flow of conversation.

What I will be grading:

Pronunciation – Are you pronouncing words correctly?

Fluency – Are you using a correct sentence structure? Do you sound natural when speaking? Is the conversation flowing or do I have to ask you lots of questions to get you to speak?

Grammar - Are you using the right tenses? Have you shown me a wide variety of tenses? Have you only spoke in the present tense?

Context – Have you developed your answers? Did you only give one sentence answers?

Possible exam questions:

2. Do you have any hobbies?
3. Why did you choose to study applied languages?
4. Do you think it's important to learn a foreign language? Why?
5. What are some advantages or disadvantages of learning a foreign language?
6. Why did you choose to learn English? What opportunities arise?

8. What are some advantages or disadvantages of AI technology?
9. Do you think AI will replace jobs in the future? Is this a good thing?
10. Do you think music is an important part of your everyday life? Why? What makes it important?
11. Can music be recreational?
12. Who is your favourite music artist and why? Is there a song that you particularly like? Why?
13. Why is gender equality important?
14. Do you think we should introduce paid menstrual leave in France?
15. how can gender equality be improved?
